Chestfield comprises of 1400 dwellings. It has one church, one pub/restaurant and a variety of sporting activities. The WI hall is located in the centre of the village. The local shops, post office and primary school are located close by in Swalecliffe together with two other churches. It has an active Parish Council which publishes information via the notice boards, the local press, the village website and the village magazine which is delivered to every house quarterly.
